Olympic

Experts say she could hold about 3,000 people. She weighed more than 40,000 tons. After the Titanic sunk she had to get her watertight doors stronger. The Olympics' watertight doors could keep water out Some say she was the greatest ship ever to sail. In 1935 she was dismantled in to scrap metal.

Titanic

Do you think the Titanic sunk, if so you're right. The Titanic was built in 1910 and finished on 1912. The Titanic could fit about 3,000 or more people. On her maiden voyage she had 2,000 people. When she was about to hit the iceberg 1st officer William Murdock put the telegraph to full speed. Experts say if the people in the crow's nest had binoculars and they went slow they would have turned and they would not have hit the iceberg. After it sunk only 706 people survived and 1,517 people died; more people died than survived. Years have past and now it's the 101st anniversary of the Titanic.



Britannic

Do you know that the Britannic was a hospital ship? She was much safer than the Titanic. The Britannic had 18 compartments so that meant if 6 watertight doors were flooded the ship would stay afloat. She was sunk by a torpedo. The torpedo opened up 2 water tight compartments. They tried to close the doors but 2 watertight doors failed to close and that filled the 6th and 7th compartments. They knew that the Britannic was going to sink. The Britannic sunk in 55 minutes, 30 out of 1,000 people died and 970 out of 1,000 people survived. The ship is in its grave, now its history. If you go to the bottom of the ocean you will see the Britannic on its side.



Now the 3 sisters are in haven they are really old, the Titanic is 101 years old, the Olympic is 104 years old and the Britannic is 98 years old. We will always remember them.
