in its own way

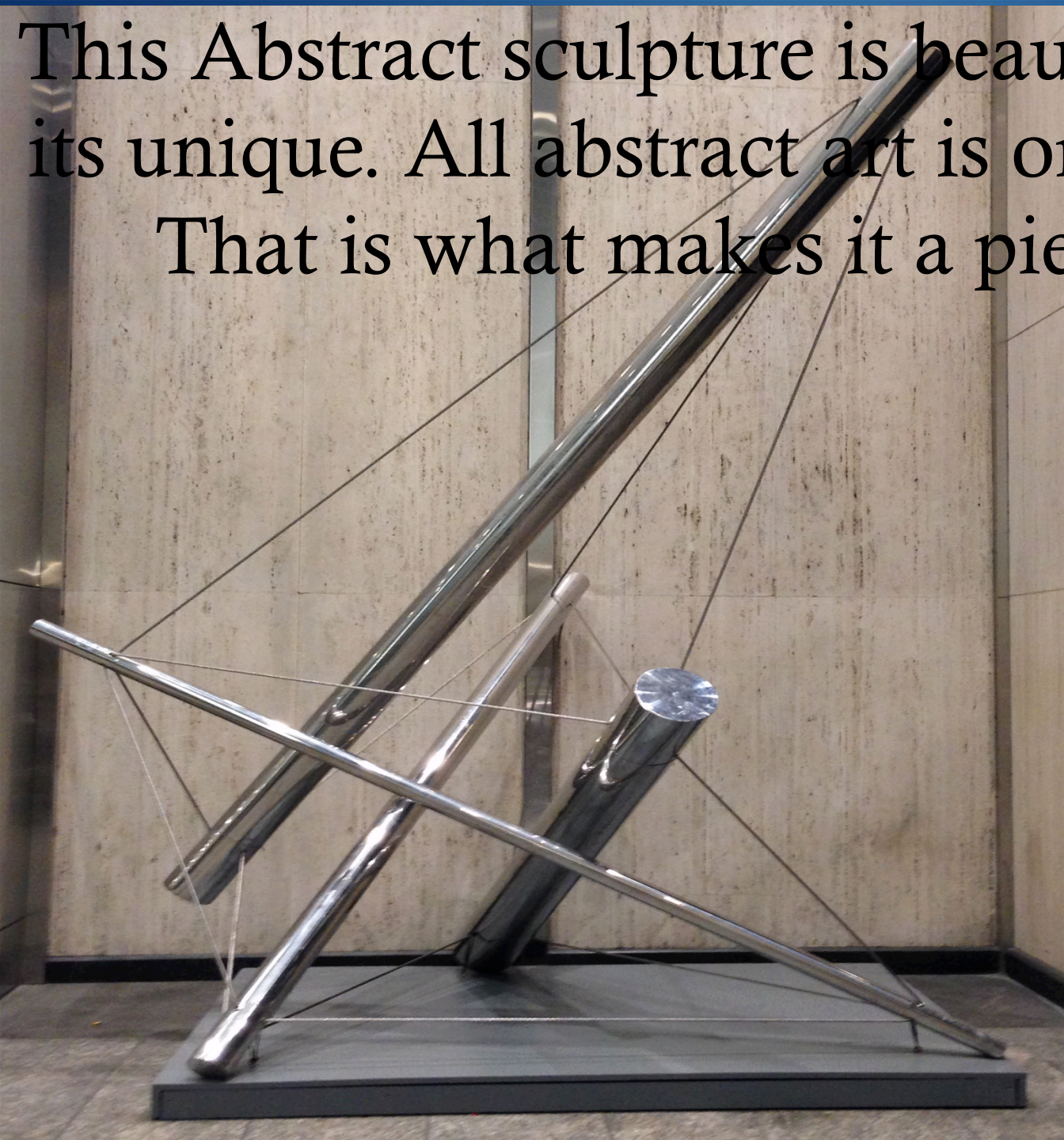

This painting is beautiful because of how the artist made it very simple and how the artist used the oil pastels in a way to make no sharp edges.

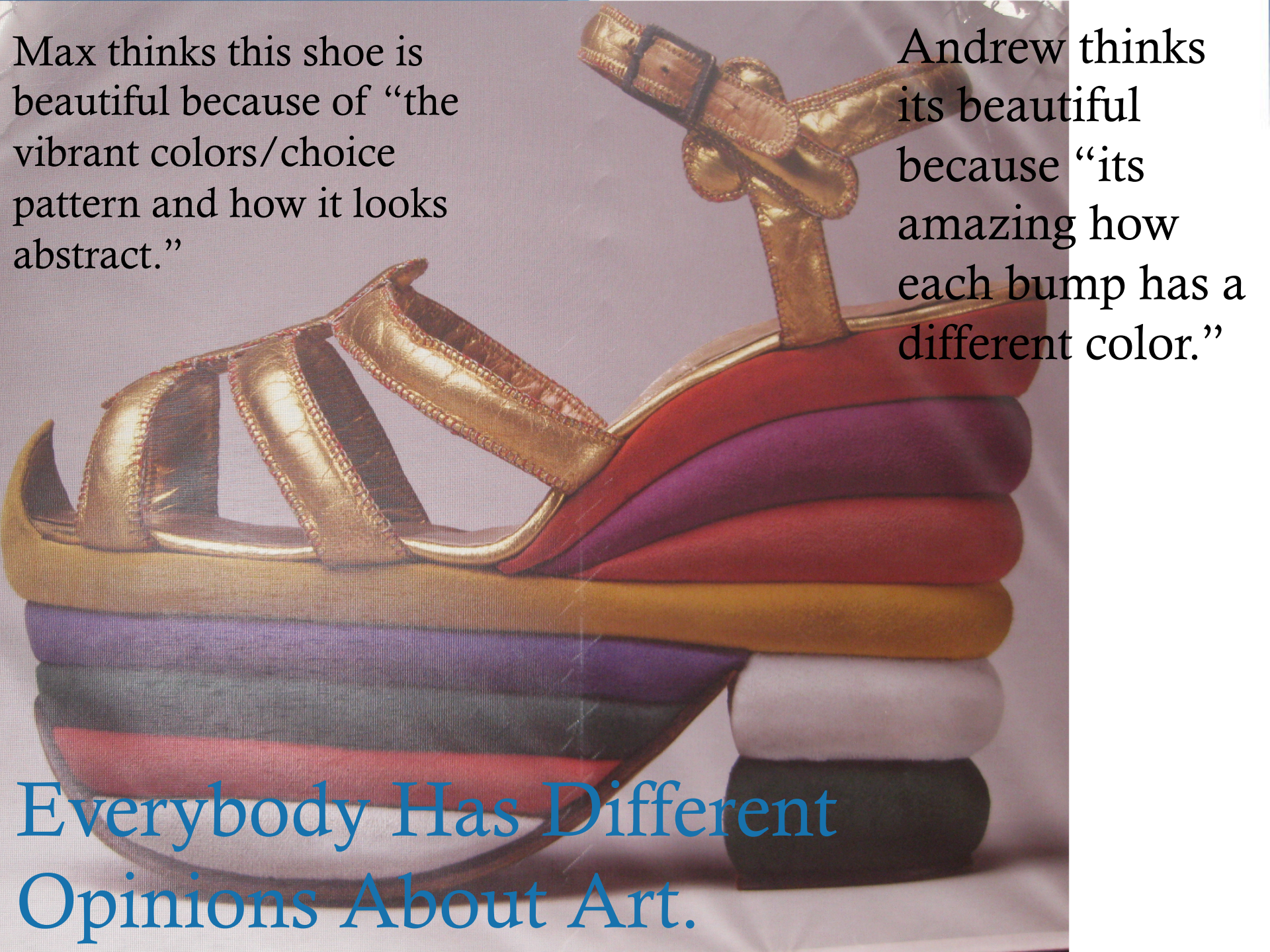


This bowl of fruit is beautiful because of how it looked like someone sewed it but it was actually a painting. Some art is like this, that is what makes it a piece of art.
