

# Randall's Island

Randall's island is a sporting oasis in the middle of NYC that is 516 acres. It has many activities there like Baseball/softball, Soccer, Tennis, Golf, Biking etc. It also holds ICAHN stadium which has track and field events and competitions.

Randall's island has been around along time. In 1936 Randall's island park was opened by the President of the United States, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, to the public and was a recreational wonderland for a long time. Then in the 1980's it fell into serious disrepair and Randall's island and Wards island, which was the island right next to Randall's became filled with construction debris. Then in 1992, the Randall's Island Park Alliance (RIPA) was formed to help or revive the park. RIPA had moved all the debris into the space between Randall's and Wards island and made it one island. They repaired Randall's island and also build ICAHN stadium. They also renovated the golf centers and made bike paths which is now present day Randall's Island.

Randall's island is a great place to spend the weekend at for sports. My family and I go there every weekend for my baseball games. I like Randall's island because it's a giant recreational park in the middle of NYC.

# SOCCER

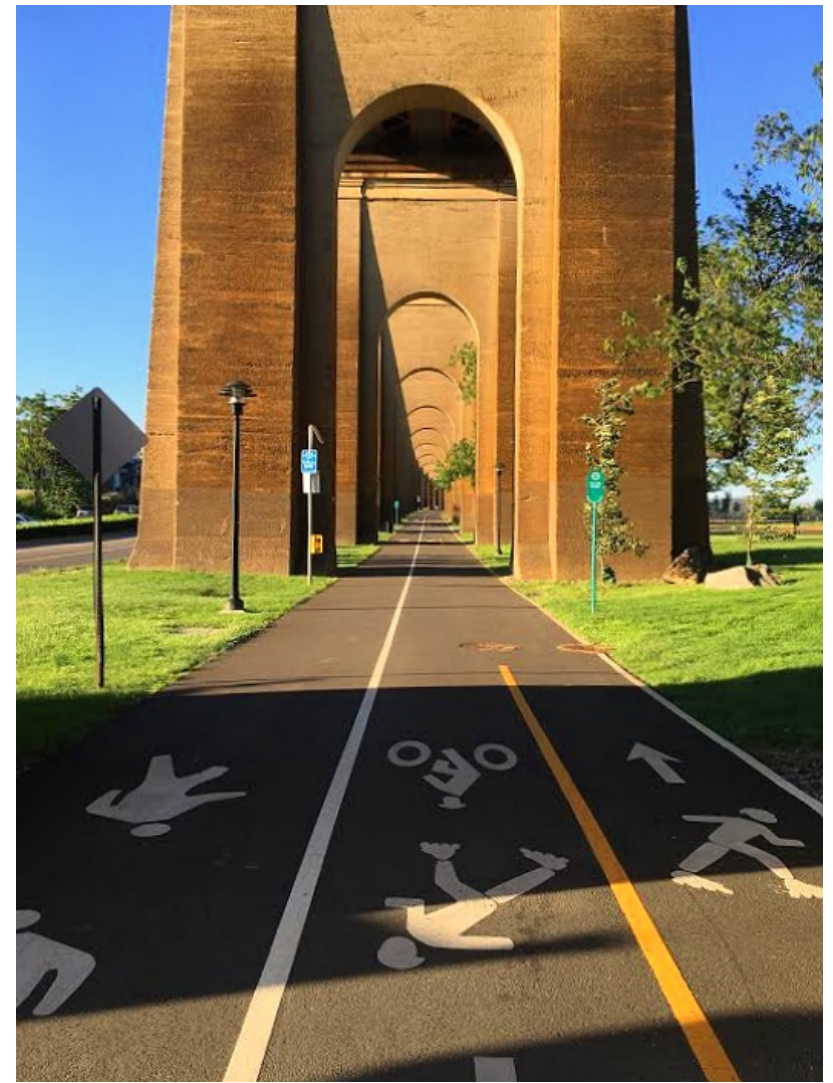


There are **22** total fields to play **soccer** on the Island.

**ICAHN stadium cost 42 million dollars to build, and it houses 5,000 seats to watch track and field events.**
