But there are some things that make the cost of dog grooming more expensive, or less expensive. For example, the bigger the dog is, the higher the price. A small dog can cost \$75 to groom, while an extra-large dog can cost \$135! Another thing that can change the cost is the type of dog. When pets are being groomed, they get a lot of attention. This includes music, cake, a freshwater bar, a professional photographer to take photos, gift bags, and decorations. The overall cost is about \$100. Interview with Bill Hubner
